



MACKSVILLE CBD UPGRADE

The Nambucca Valley has secured funding from the State Government (\$577,500) under the "Fixing Local Roads Project" and together with Council's cocontribution (\$192,500) we plan to rehabilitate parts of the Macksville CBD.

This project is in line with Council's Revitalisation Concept Plan and will provide improvements to water services, roads, access and pavement to ensure future economic growth and tourism in the area, while supporting small businesses.

Estimated Construction Dates

- May-June Commence Water Services
 - June-July Commence kerb and subsoil
- August Commence road reconstruction (night works)


Council's General Manager and Engineering team will be attending to provide details on the scope of works and answer any questions if applicable.
