- (a) Animal matter (including carcasses but not including human waste), wool, hair, grease, dust, ashes, cinders, soil, rubbish, filth, oil, salt, mud, sand, gravel, garbage, offal, vegetable or fruit parings, rags, house refuse, steam or solid matter;
- (b) Any flammable or explosive substance;
- (c) Waste liquid that contains a percentage of any substance, or waste liquid that is of a temperature, specified by the council as being:
  - (i) likely to endanger public health, public safety or public amenity or the environment, or
  - (ii) damaging to, or liable to form compounds that may damage, the council's sewerage system or treatment works, or
  - (iii) likely to injure employees engaged in the operation or maintenance of the council's sewerage system or treatment works or the health of those employees;
- (d) Except in the case of a public drain or a council gutter roof, rain, surface, flood, seepage or subsoil water.

In addition to those mentioned in clause 6 of the Local Government (Water Services) Regulation 1999, the following substances are not permitted to be discharged into the sewerage system:

- solid matter of any kind;
- organochlorine weedicides, fungicides, pesticides, herbicides and substances of similar nature and/or wastes arising from the preparation of these substances;
- any substances liable to produce noxious or poisonous vapours in the sewerage system;
- discharges from bulk fuel depots;
- organic solvents and mineral oils;
- natural or synthetic resins, plastic monomers, synthetic adhesives and rubber plastic emulsions;
- chromate from cooling towers;
- waste liquids that contain pollutants at concentrations which inhibit the sewage treatment processes Guidelines for Sewerage Systems: Acceptance of Trade Waste (Industrial Waste) (ARMCANZ/ANZECC, 1994); and,
- any substance assessed as unsuitable for discharge into the sewerage system.
